



## Catch 2 Million

### Key Terms & Conditions and Mechanics

#### 1. Catch 2 Million Key Terms & Conditions

- A share of R2 000 000.00 for any person/s who catch a six with one hand in accordance with the Competition T&C's.
- Should there be more than one winner during the Competition; the R2 000 000.00 Prize Money will be shared between the winners.
- To qualify for the Prize, the following criteria must apply to a winning catch –
  - (a) It must be a clean, one-handed catch off a 'six' hit during a televised RAM Slam Cricket match (juggling the ball between hands will not be accepted as a clean catch);
  - (b) the catch must be clearly visible on stadium video and TV camera as it will be audited
  - (c) No gloves or any other form of artificial assistance may be used to catch the ball with.
- A clean catch is one where the ball does not make contact with anything or any other person after leaving the bat until caught one handed by the participant after being struck out of the field of play.
- Either hand may be used to make a clean catch.
- The competition is only applicable for TELEVISED matches
- There is no age Limit, but should a catch be taken by a spectator who is Under 18, the money will be put into a trust account or a suitable Interest Bearing Account for the participant until he/she reaches the age of 18.
- Participants must have a valid South African ID and Bank Account

## 2. Catch 2 Million Key Mechanics

- The catch will be televised
- If a spectator catches a six, the umpires will call on the 3<sup>rd</sup> umpire to review
- The catch will be adjudicated by an Independent adjudicator appointed by CSA
- The catch will be replayed in studio
- The Adjudicator will confirm or deny the catch
- The Adjudicator will give feedback to the Mscsports Event Manager and the SuperSport Commentators / PA Announcer
- The Commentators and PA Announcer will announce the winner
- The cameraman will zoom in on the winner and put him up on the big screen
- The Mscsports representative will go and meet the winner and will take them aside in order to verify that all terms and conditions are met.
- Photo opportunity of the winner with the player which hit the six POST Match
- Photos and winners details sent to RAM and CSA Social Media teams to be posted on Facebook, Instagram and Twitter
- Winner taken down to field to allow media photographers to take pictures for various publications and to do interview with SuperSport
- PR team notified immediately once the catch has been taken in order for the media release to be prepped along with photographs and sent out immediately
- Winner's details are captured and sent through to JHB to verify the following day.
- Letter to be sent to the winner post-match / catch advising them of the terms and conditions of the catch (i.e. the winnings could be split, payment date etc.)
