# LEVEL D LINEAR TRAINING COURSE



## Linear Scoring System

The linear form of cricket scoring is growing in popularity and, as the preferred scoring system of Cricket South Africa, has now been introduced at all levels of cricket in KwaZulu-Natal.

Linear scoring consists of two sheets – a worksheet and a summary sheet. Every ball is recorded on the worksheet and information transferred onto the summary sheet. The worksheet shows every ball, run and wicket and you can quickly see which batsman faced which delivery and what the total was after every over. The worksheet has space for the two batsmen currently batting, as well as for the two bowlers currently bowling. The summary sheet is exactly what its name suggests, i.e. a summary of the match. All the players' stats are calculated from this sheet and no match can be concluded without a completed summary sheet for each innings.

As soon as you know the theory, and start practicing it, the easier the method becomes and the quicker you will improve.

## KwaZulu-Natal Cricket Scorers' Association

The KwaZulu-Natal Cricket Scorers' Association (KZNCSA) was formed in 1996.

The Association has an elected President who is assisted by an Executive Committee. The Scorers' Association is governed by a Constitution and its members adhere to a strict Code of Conduct.

Scorers for all first class matches played in the Greater Durban and Pietermaritzburg areas are appointed by the Association.

The KZN Cricket Scorers' Association has been nominated for the SA Provincial Cricket Scorers' Association of the Year Award on a number of occasions and has won the Award once.
